

Fat Quarter Flowers Quilt

Shortcut Pattern



Finished Size: 52 1/2" x 65 1/2"

Fabric Requirements

- Ten Fat Quarters or 18" x 20" rectangles
- 2 1/2 yards background fabric
- 5/8 yard binding fabric
- 3 1/2 yards backing fabric
- 7" Half Square Triangle Paper - Triangles on a Roll #H700

cutting

- Cut each 18" x 20" rectangle into:
 - 2 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles - 20 total (Fabric A)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 20 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles (Fabric B)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 7 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric C)
- Cut 7" Half Square Triangle Paper into:
 - 20 - one by two sections (2 squares each)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly:

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A rectangle with a Fabric B rectangle.

Place a one by two section of 7" Triangles on a Roll on top and pin in place.

Set stitch length to 1.5 and sew on the dotted lines.

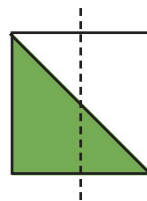
Cut apart on the solid lines.

Half Square Triangle Unit should measure 7 1/2" x 7 1/2".



Make eighty.

Cut each Half Square Triangle Unit in half vertically. Print Rectangle Unit and Background Rectangle Unit should measure 3 3/4" x 7 1/2".

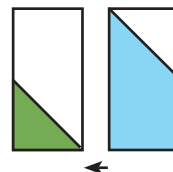


Make eighty Print Rectangle Units.

Make eighty Background Rectangle Units.

Assemble one Background Rectangle Unit and one different Print Rectangle Unit.

Partial Petal Unit should measure 7" x 7 1/2".



Make eighty.

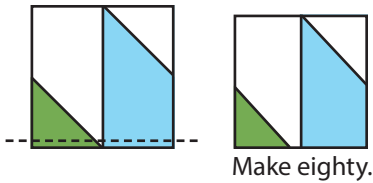

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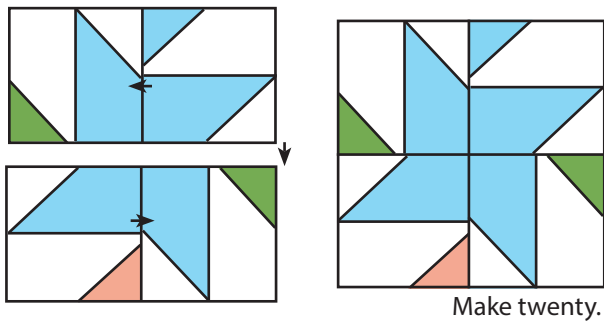
Fat Quarter Flowers Quilt

Trim Petal Unit to measure 7" x 7".



Assemble the Flower Block using matching Print Rectangle Units.

Flower Block should measure 13 1/2" x 13 1/2".

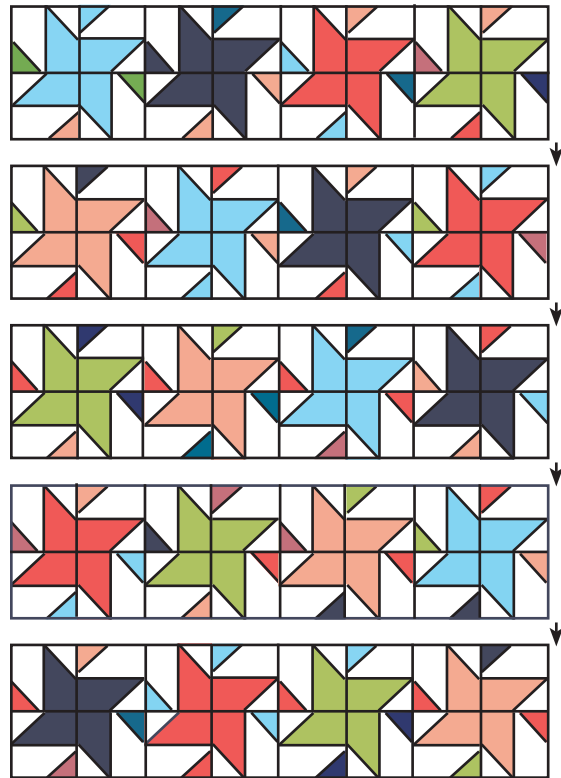


Quilt Center:

Assemble the Quilt Center. Rotate blocks so seams nest.

Press rows in opposite directions.

Quilt Center should measure 52 1/2" x 65 1/2".



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric C strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.

Fat Quarter Flowers Sizing Guide

Shortcut Pattern

Follow the Block Assembly instructions in the original Fat Quarter Flowers pattern. This reference guide will assist in making the quilt in different sizes.

Crib Quilt

Finished Size: 39 1/2" x 52 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

Six Fat Quarters or 18" x 20" rectangles

1 5/8 yards background fabric

5/8 yard binding fabric

2 3/4 yards backing fabric

7" Half Square Triangle Paper Triangles on a Roll #H700

Cutting:

Cut each 18" x 20" rectangle into:

2 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles - 12 total (Fabric A)

Cut background fabric into:

12 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles (Fabric B)

Cut binding fabric into:

6 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric C)

Cut 7" Half Square Triangle Paper into:

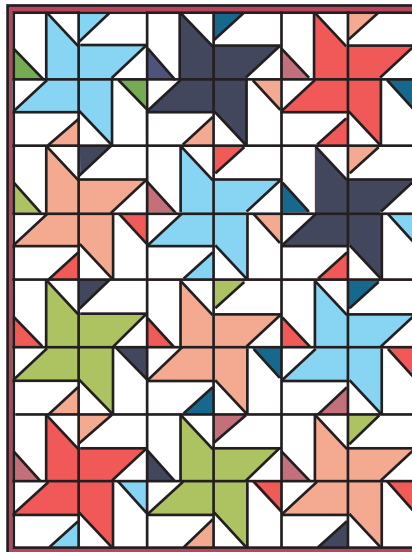
12 - one by two sections (2 squares each)

Lap Quilt

Refer to the Fat Quarter Flowers pattern for the Lap Quilt.

Instructions:

Make twelve Flower Blocks.

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Fat Quarter Flowers Sizing Guide

Shortcut Pattern

Twin Quilt

Finished Size: 65 1/2" x 91 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

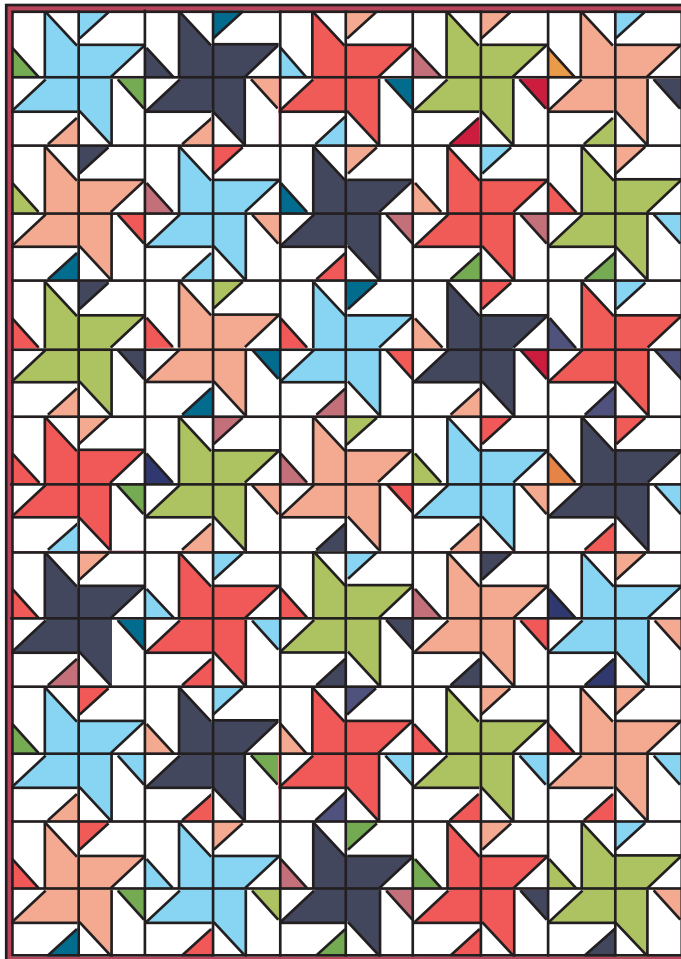
- Eighteen Fat Quarters or 18" x 20" rectangles
- 4 3/8 yards background fabric
- 7/8 yard binding fabric
- 5 2/3 yards backing fabric
- 7" Half Square Triangle Paper Triangles on a Roll #H700

Cutting:

- Cut each 18" x 20" rectangle into:
 - 2 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles - 36 total (Fabric A)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 36 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles (Fabric B)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 9 - 2 1/2" width of fabric strips (Fabric C)
- Cut 7" Half Square Triangle Paper into:
 - 36 - one by two sections (2 squares each)

Instructions:

- Make thirty-five Flower Blocks.
- (You will not use four Flower Units).



Fat Quarter Flowers Sizing Guide

Shortcut Pattern

Queen Quilt

Finished Size: 91 1/2" x 91 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

Twenty-five Fat Quarters or 18" x 20" rectangles

6 1/8 yards background fabric

7/8 yard binding fabric

8 1/2 yards backing fabric

7" Half Square Triangle Paper

Triangles on a Roll #H700

Cutting:

Cut each 18" x 20" rectangle into:

2 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles - 50 total (Fabric A)

Cut background fabric into:

50 - 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles (Fabric B)

Cut binding fabric into:

10 - 2 1/2" width of fabric strips (Fabric C)

Cut 7" Half Square Triangle Paper into:

50 - one by two sections (2 squares each)

Instructions:

Make forty-nine Flower Blocks.

(You will not use four Flower Units).
