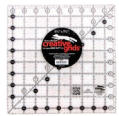

Cutting Instructions:

One Block	
Block Print	1 - 6 1/2" square (A) 1 - 5" square (B) 1 - 3 1/4" x 10 3/4" rectangle (C) 1 - 3 1/4" x 8" rectangle (D)
Block Background	1 - 6 1/2" square (E) 1 - 5" square (F) 1 - 3 1/4" x 10 3/4" rectangle (G) 1 - 3 1/4" x 8" rectangle (H)

Creative Grids 9 1/2" Quilting Square Ruler #CGR9



Creative Grids 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" Quilting Square Ruler #CGR824

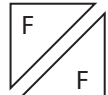
Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly:

Cut the Fabric B square and the Fabric F square on the diagonal once. You will not use one Fabric B triangle and one Fabric F triangle.

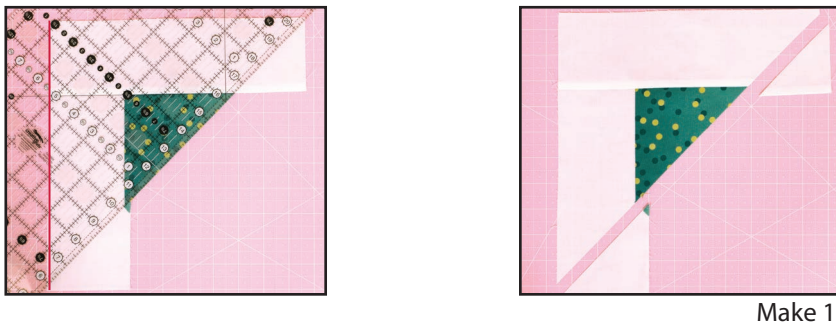

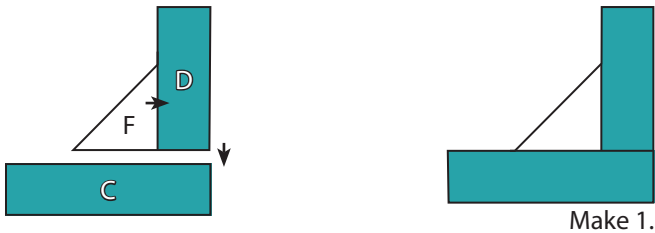
Assemble the Fabric H rectangle, the Fabric B triangle and the Fabric G rectangle.
Make one Partial Light Hunter's Star Unit.



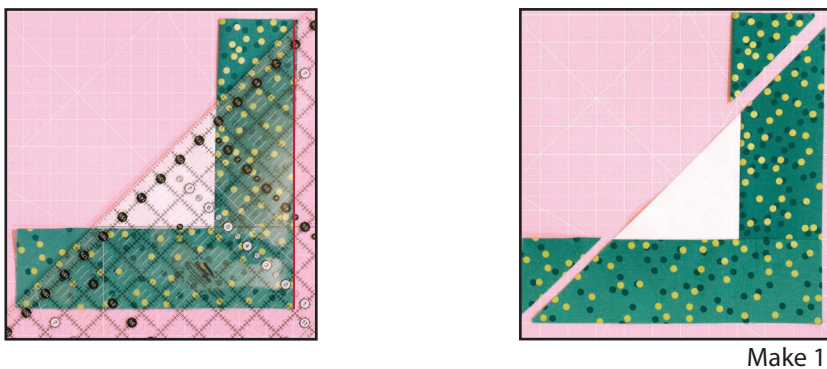
Using the 45 degree line on a quilting ruler, trim the Partial Light Hunter's Star Unit.
Make one Light Hunter's Star Unit.



Assemble the Fabric F triangle, the Fabric D rectangle and the Fabric C rectangle.
Make one Partial Dark Hunter's Star Unit.



Using the 45 degree line on a quilting ruler, trim the Partial Dark Hunter's Star Unit.
Make one Dark Hunter's Star Unit.

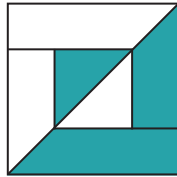
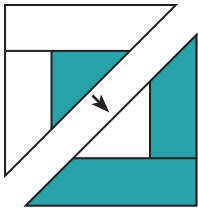

Assemble the Light Hunter's Star Unit and the Dark Hunter's Star Unit.

Trim Hunter's Star Unit to measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$.

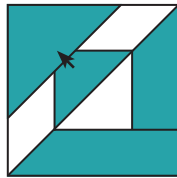
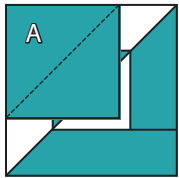


Make 1.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A square and the Fabric E square.

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric A square on the top left corner of the Hunter's Star Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom right corner with the Fabric E square.

Hunter's Star Block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$.
