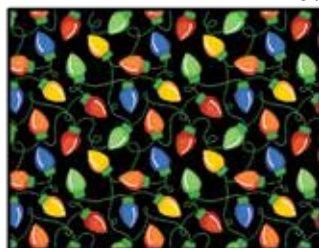

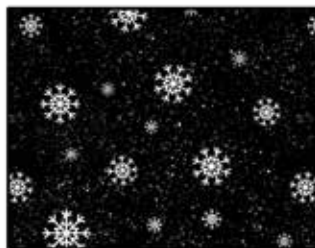

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Materials

1 ½ yards	Santa Blocks - Multi (A)	6751-89
7/8 yard	Snowflake - Red (B)	6756-88*
¼ yard	Snowflake - Green (C)	6756-66
¼ yard	Lights - White/Multi (D)	6752-86
¼ yard	Tossed Toys - Black (E)	6753-99
¼ yard	Tossed Santa - Black (F)	6754-99
1 ⅔ yards	Toy Patch - Multi (Backing)	6755-89

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Santa Blocks - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (3) 6 ½" x 48 ½" LOF strips, each centered on (2) rows of blocks.

From the Snowflake - Red (B), cut:

- (9) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Snowflake - Green (C), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 3 ½" squares.

From the Lights - White/Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Toys - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (6) 6 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Santa - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Toy Patch - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (1) 56" x WOF strips for the backing.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

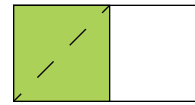

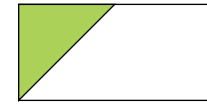

2. Place another 3 ½" Fabric C square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) CDC unit.

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (12) CDC units total.

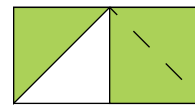

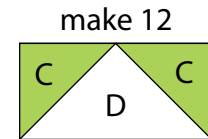

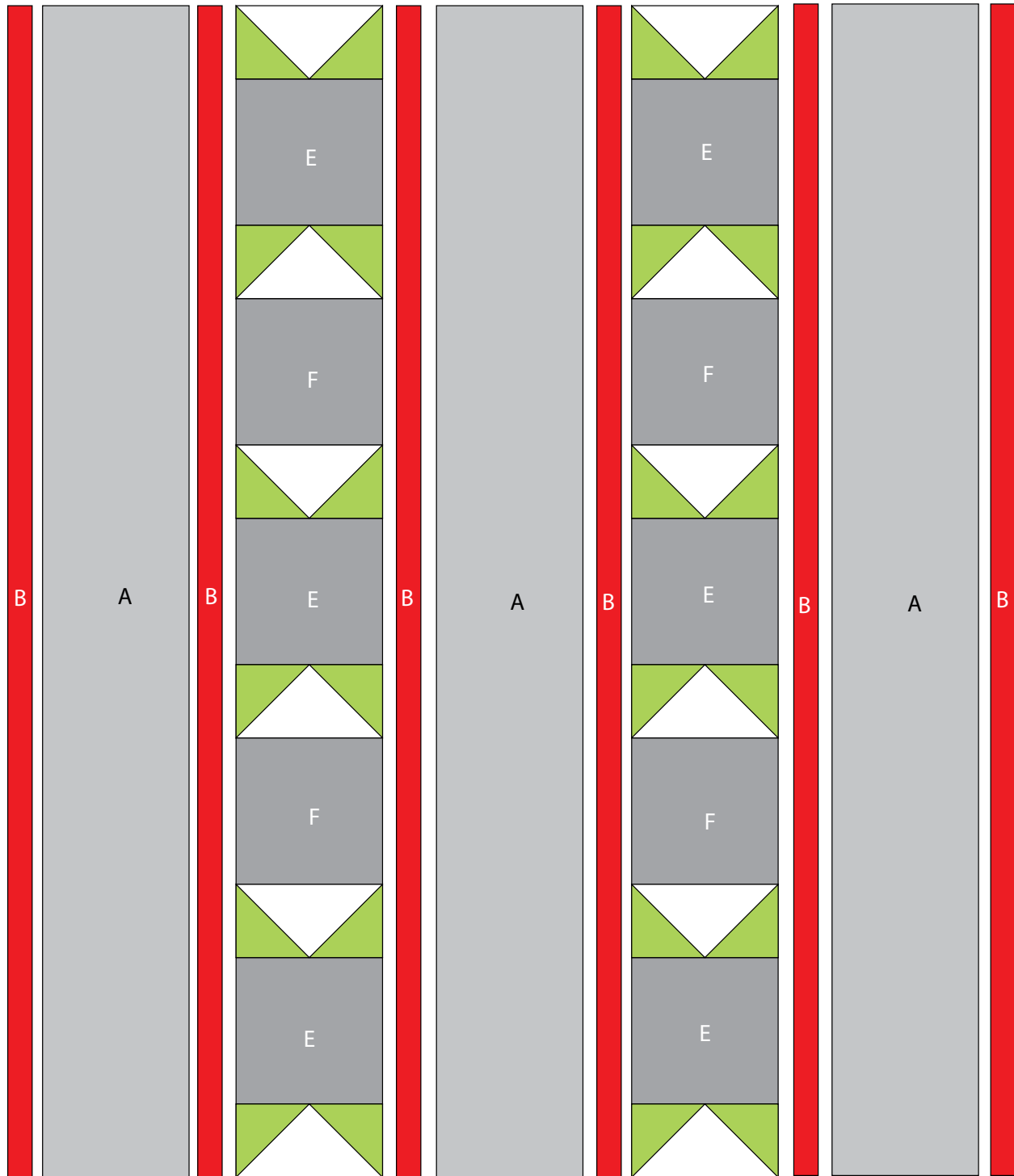
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

4. Sew (6) CDC units, (3) 6 ½" Fabric E squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares together lengthwise to make (1) pieced column. Repeat to make a second pieced column. Pay attention to the orientation of the units.
5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side (1) 6 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric A strip to make (1) A column. Repeat to make (3) A columns total.
6. Sew the (3) A columns and (2) pieced columns together lengthwise and alternating them, to make the quilt top.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.
