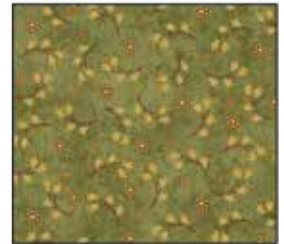

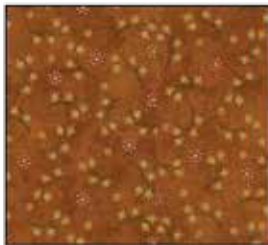

3/8 yard	Flower Sprig - Green (I)	8461-66
3/8 yard	Vine Stripe - Green (J)	8459-66
3/8 yard	Word Stripe - Red (K)	8462-88
3/8 yard	Flower Sprig - Red (L)	8461-88

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Hexagon Words - Navy (A), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Fruits of the Spirit - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) 4 1/2" squares.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Daisy Dot - Gold (C), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Small Check - Gold (D), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Word Stripe - Cream (E), cut:

- (14) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (120) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Small Check - Cream (F), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (120) 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 42 1/2" strips.

From the Hexagon Words - Red (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (30) hearts.

From the Fruits of the Spirit - Red (H), cut:

- See instructions to cut (30) hearts.

From the Flower Sprig - Green (I), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (60) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Green (J), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (60) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Word Stripe - Red (K), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (30) hearts.

From the Flower Sprig - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (30) hearts.

From the Daisy Dot - Red (M), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Hexagon Words - Brown (N), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Brown (O), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (11) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Pumpkin (P), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Flower Sprig - Pumpkin (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 65" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 2 ½” Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ½” x 4 ½” Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼” seam allowance.

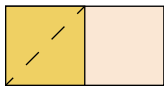

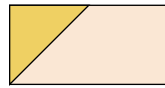

2. Place (1) 2 ½” Fabric C square on the right side of the 2 ½” x 4 ½” Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼” seam allowance to make (1) DEC unit.

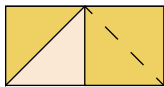

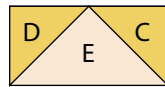

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (60) units total.

4. Sew (1) DEC unit to each side of (1) 4 ½” Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 ½” Fabric F square to each end of (1) DEC unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) A-block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (15) A-blocks total.

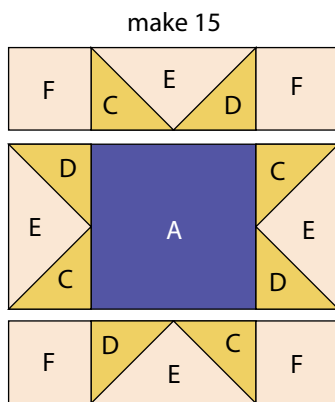

5. Following the manufacturer’s instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about ⅛” outside the drawn lines.

6. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

7. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (2) Fabric G Hearts and (2) Fabric Hearts onto the corners of the A-block as shown in Figure 6.

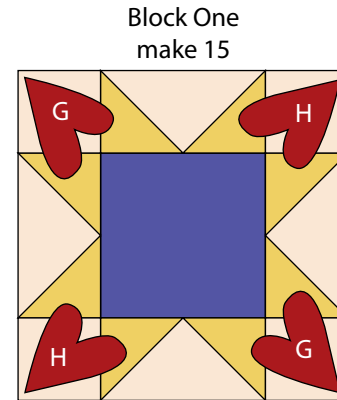

8. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the (15) Block Ones.

9. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (60) 2 ½” x 4 ½” Fabric E strips, (60) 2 ½” Fabric J squares and (60) 2 ½” Fabric I squares to make (60) JEI units (Fig. 7).

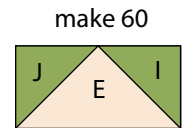

10. Sew (1) JEI unit to each side of (1) 4 ½” Fabric B square. Sew (1) 2 ½” Fabric F square to each end of (1) JEI unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B square to make (1) B-block (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (15) B-blocks total.

11. Repeat Steps 5-8 using (15) B-blocks, (30) Fabric K Hearts and (30) Fabric L Hearts to make (15) Block Twos (Fig. 9).

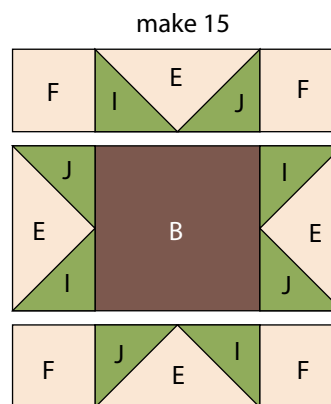

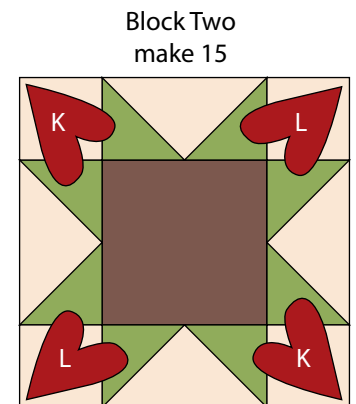

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

12. Sew (3) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.

13. Sew (3) Block Twos and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six.

14. Sew the (6) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.

15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

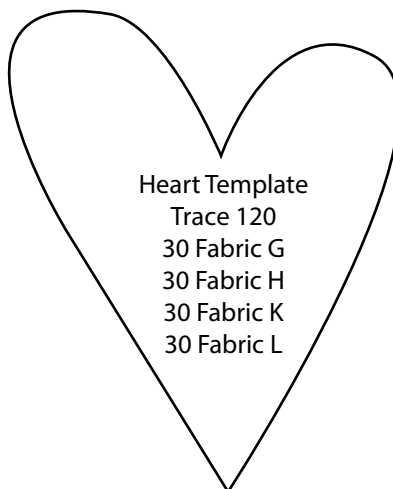
16. Sew (17) assorted 3 ½" squares together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the quilt top.

17. Sew (16) assorted 3 ½" squares together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

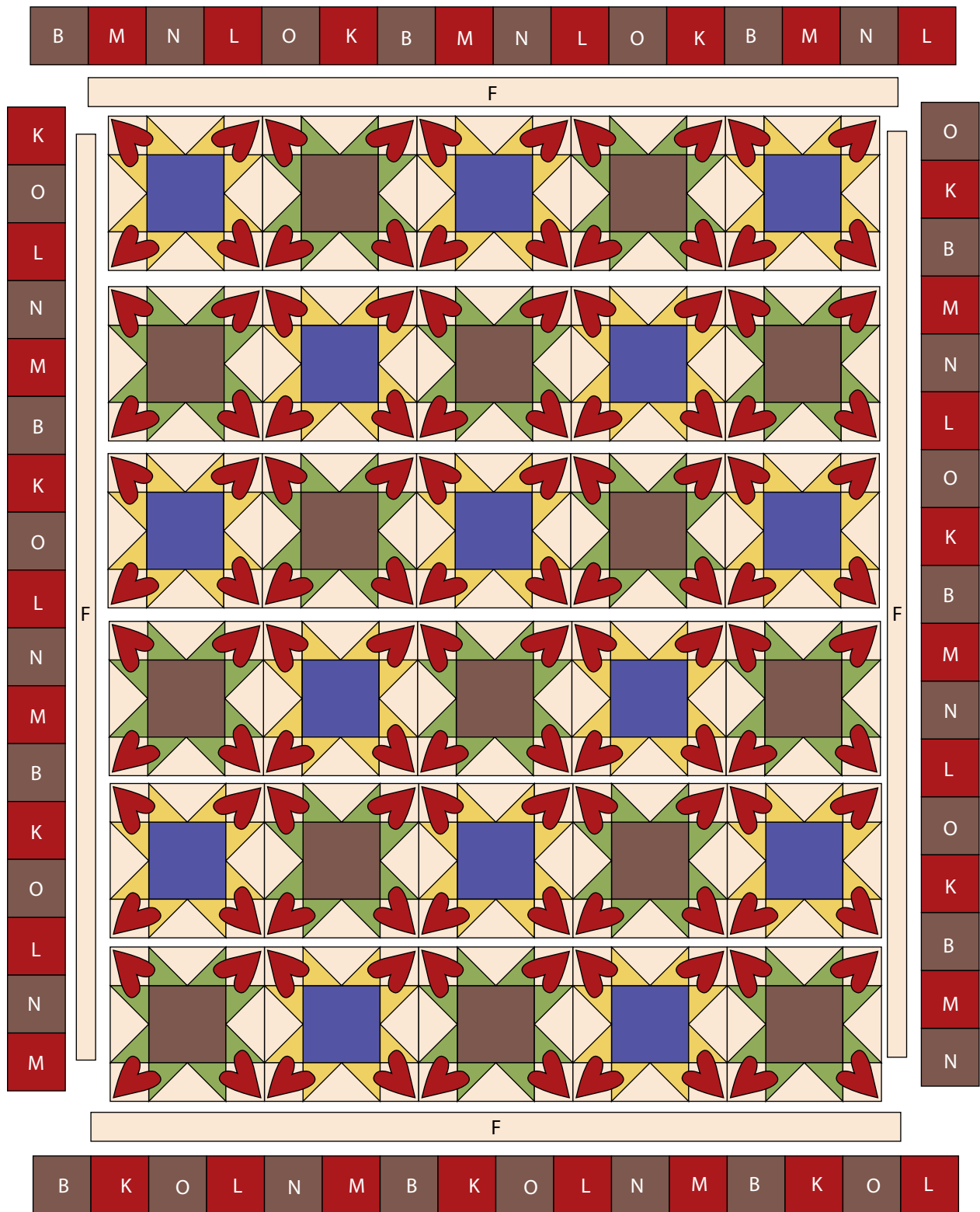
19. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric P strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
