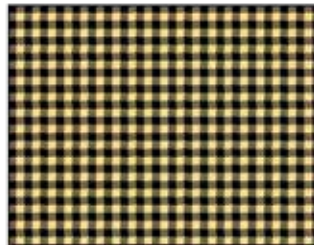

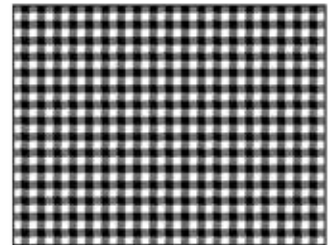

5/8 yard	Tossed Bees - Green (C)	6644-66
1/3 yard	Tossed Beehives - Yellow (D)	6648-44
5/8 yard	Tossed Beehives - Black (E)	6648-99
1/3 yard	Patchwork - Multi (F)	6641-94
7/8 yard	Check - Yellow/Blk (G)	6646-94
5/8 yard	Embroidery Stitch - Black (H)	6645-99
2 1/4 yards	Novelty Stripe - Multi (I)	6640-94
1/2 yard	Honeycomb - Gray (J)	6643-90
2/3 yard	Check - Blk/Wht (K)	6646-9*
3 3/4 yards	Patchwork - Multi (Backing)	6641-94

*Includes binding

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Floral - White (A), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 8 1/2" squares

From the Floral - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 8 1/2" squares

From the Tossed Bees - Green (C), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) 8 1/2" squares

From the Tossed Beehives - Yellow (D), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 8 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Beehives - Black (E), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 8 1/2" squares

From the Patchwork - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" square.

From the Check - Yellow/Blk (G), cut:

- (3) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (82) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Embroidery Stitch - Black (H), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (48) 1 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (72) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 6" x 79" LOF strips.
- (2) 6" x 61" LOF strips.

From the Honeycomb - Gray (J), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (68) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Check - Blk/Wht (K), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 65" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 83" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square on the top left corner of (1) 8 1/2" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

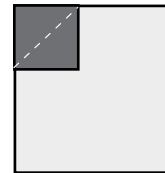

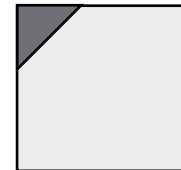

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric H square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 1/2" Fabric A square to make (1) A block (Fig. 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (8) A blocks total.

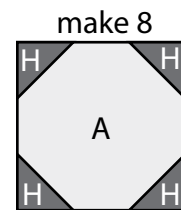

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (4) 8 1/2" Fabric D squares and (16) 2 1/2" Fabric H squares to make (4) D blocks (Fig. 5).

5. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (6) 8 1/2" Fabric C squares and (24) 2 1/2" Fabric H squares to make (6) C blocks (Fig. 6).

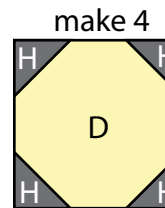

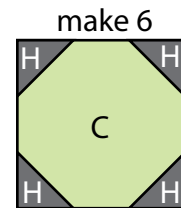

6. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (8) 8 1/2" Fabric B squares and (32) 2 1/2" Fabric J squares to make (8) B blocks (Fig. 7).

7. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (8) 8 1/2" Fabric E squares and (32) 2 1/2" Fabric J squares to make (8) E blocks (Fig. 8).

8. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (1) 8 1/2" Fabric F square and (4) 2 1/2" Fabric J squares to make (1) F block (Fig. 9).

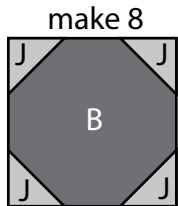

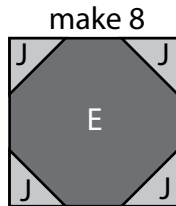

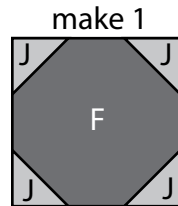

9. Sew (6) 1 1/2" Fabric H squares and (5) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) sashing strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (8) sashing strips total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

10. Sew (6) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips, (2) A blocks, (2) B blocks and (1) C block together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Seven.

11. Sew (6) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips, (2) B blocks, (2) D blocks and (1) E block together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Six.

12. Sew (6) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips, (2) C blocks, (2) E blocks and (1) A block together to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Five.

13. Sew (6) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strips, (2) E blocks, (2) A blocks and (1) F block together to make Row Four.

14. Sew the (8) sashing strips and (7) rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

15. Center (1) 6" x 79" Fabric I strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) 6" x 61" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 11).

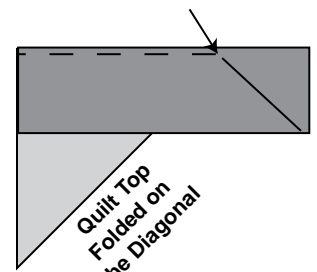

17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 11), draw a 45° line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.

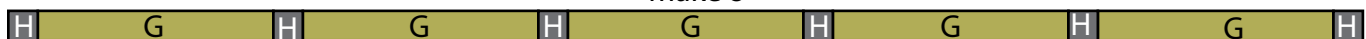
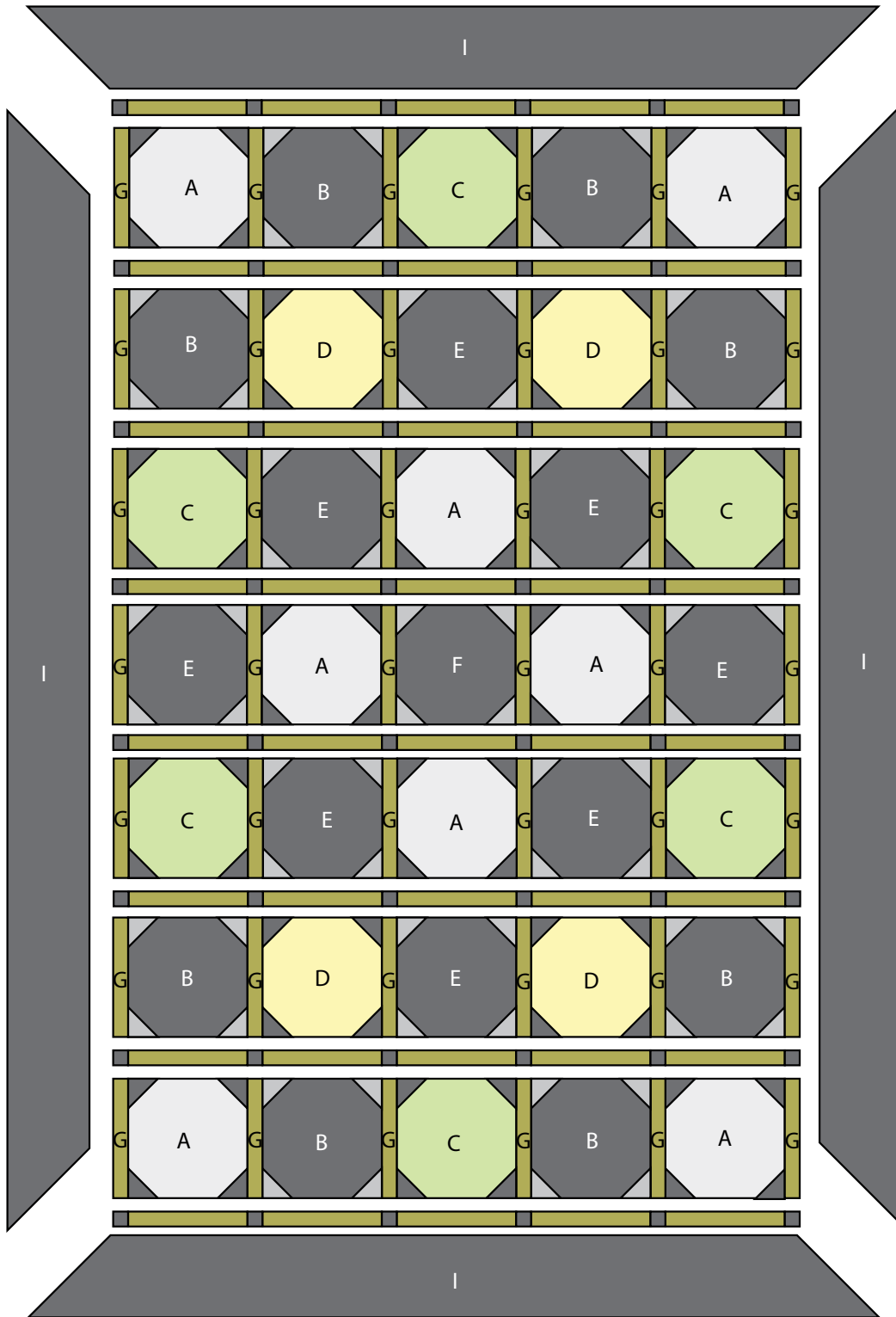
