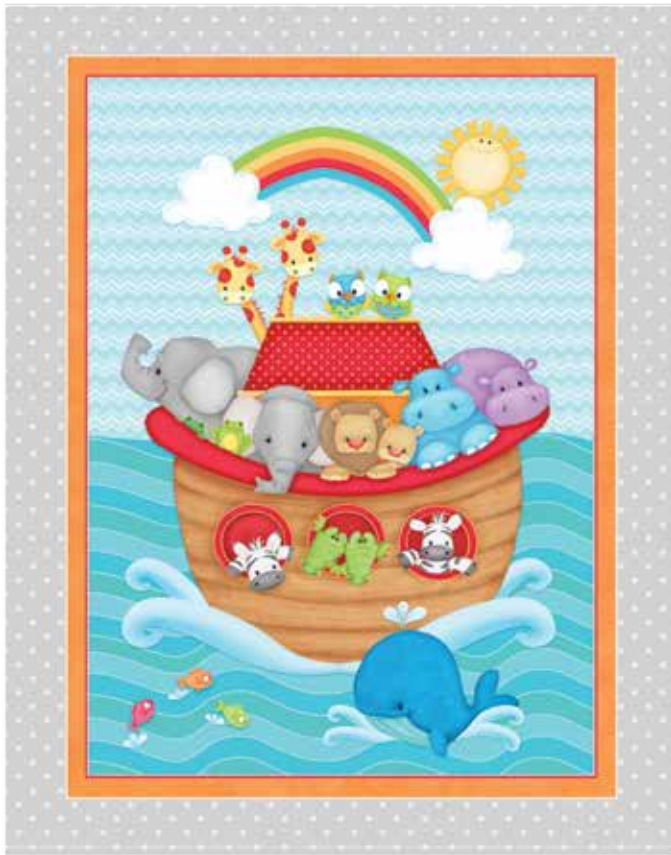

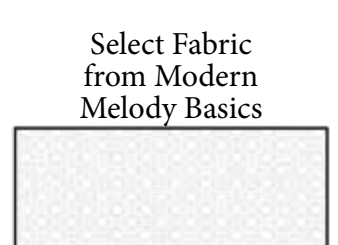

Materials

1 ¼ yards	Novelty Stripe - Multi (A)	6838-18
⅞ yard	Dot - Green (B)	6840-66*
½ yard	Plaid - Multi (C)	6836-18
¼ yard	Whales - Blue (D)	6839-11
¼ yard	Fish - Blue (E)	6860-11
½ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (F)	1063-01W
½ yard	Noah's Ark Toss - Blue (G)	6833-11
2 ¾ yards	Noah's Ark Toss - Multi (Backing)	6833-18

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (2) 11" x 40 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Dot - Green (B), cut:

- (8) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Plaid - Multi (C), cut:

- (4) 3 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 3 ⅜" squares.

From the Whales - Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles.

From the Fish - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (F), cut:

- (4) 3 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 3 ⅜" squares.

From the Noah's Ark Toss - Blue (G), fussy cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strip, centered on the line of arks.

From the Noah's Ark Toss - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 48" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48" x 62" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric F square on top of (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim blocks to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 1 blocks (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (80) Unit 1 blocks total.

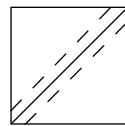

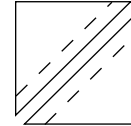

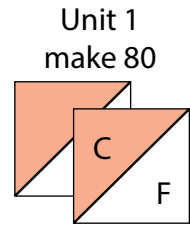

2. Sew (4) Unit 1 blocks together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.

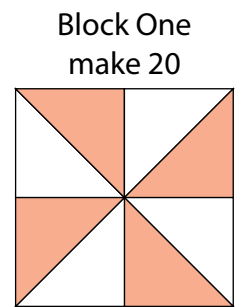

3. Sew (5) Block One squares and (4) 4 ¼" x 5 ½" Fabric D rectangles together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.

4. Sew (5) Block One squares and (4) 4 ¼" x 5 ½" Fabric E rectangles together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 strip.

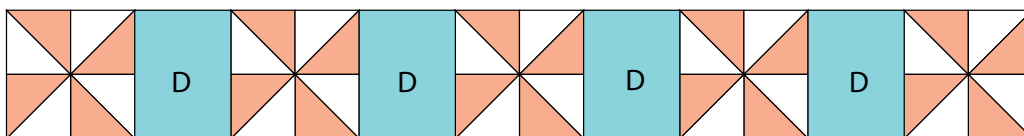

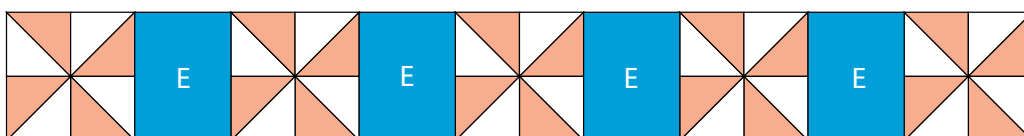

SIDE BY SIDE Quilt 2

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

5. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 11" x 40 ½" Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) A row. Repeat to make a second A row.

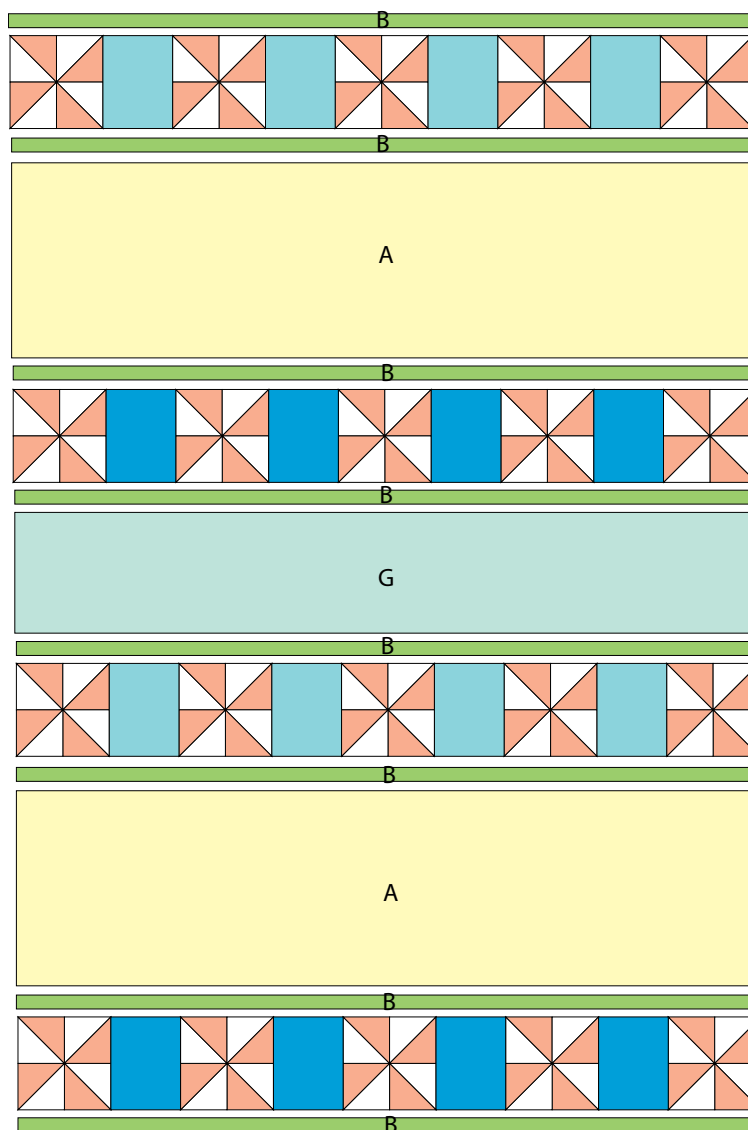
6. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric G strip lengthwise to make (1) G row.

7. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) A row, (1) Unit 3 strip, (1) G row, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) A row, (1) Unit 3 strip and (1) 1 ¼" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip together lengthwise in that order to make the quilt top.

8. Layer and quilt as desired.

9. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired.
