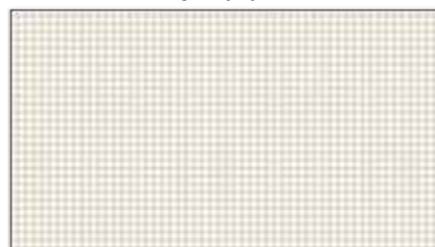

Materials

1 ¼ yards	Gingham - Blush (A)	8409-22
⅔ yard	Small Floral - Blush (B)	8411-22
1 ½ yards	Stripe - Sage (C)	8410-66
2 yards	Tender Fern - Blush (D)	8408-22
⅞ yard	Tender Fern - Sage (E)	8408-66*
⅞ yard	Master Floral - Blush (F)	8407-22
3 ¾ yards	Master Floral - Blush (Backing)	8407-22

*Includes binding

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gingham - Blush (A), cut:

- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (42) 3 ½" squares.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Small Floral - Blush (B), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Stripe - Sage (C), cut:

- (14) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (213) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Tender Fern - Blush (D), cut:

- (27) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (426) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tender Fern - Sage (E), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Master Floral - Blush (F), cut:

- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 4" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 4" x 57 ½" strips.

From the Master Floral - Blush (Backing), cut:

- (2) 65" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 74" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) ABA strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) ABA strip sets total.
2. Cut the ABA strip sets into (60) 2 ½" x 6 ½" ABA strips (Fig. 2).

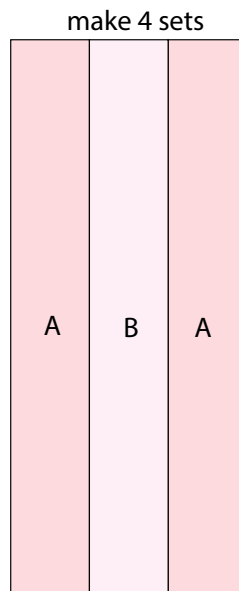

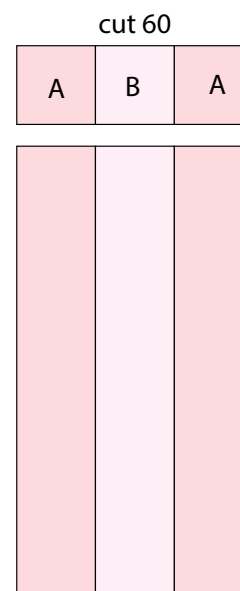

3. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) BAB strip set (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (2) BAB strip sets total.
4. Cut the BAB strip sets into (30) 2 ½" x 6 ½" BAB strips (Fig. 4).

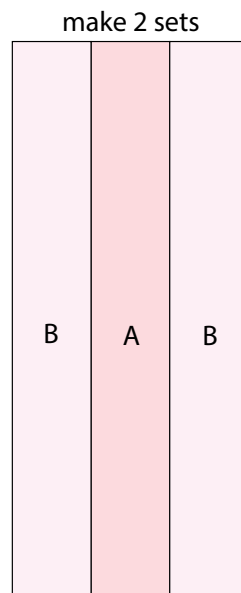

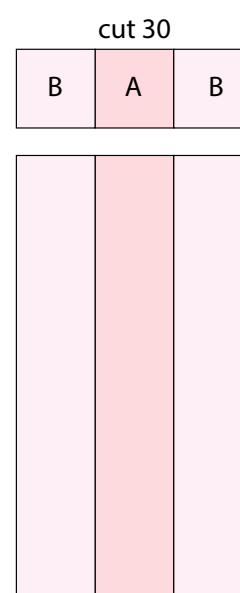

5. Sew (2) ABA and (1) BAB strips together to make (1) Block One (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (30) Block One totals.

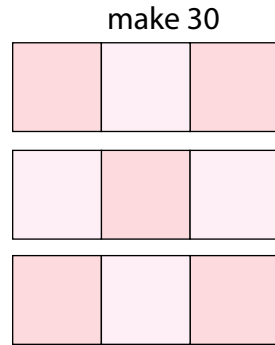

6. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

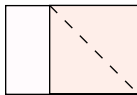

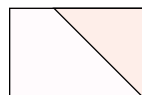

7. Place another $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) DCD unit.

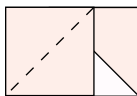

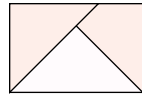

8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (213) DCD units total.

9. Sew (3) DCD units together lengthwise to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (71) Block Twos total.

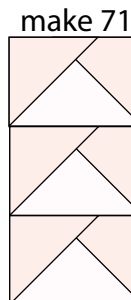

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

10. Sew (6) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares and (5) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make (1) sashing strip. Repeat to make (7) sashing strips total.

11. Sew (6) Block Twos and (5) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make (1) pieced row. Repeat to make (6) pieced rows total.

12. Sew the (7) sashing strips and (6) pieced rows together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

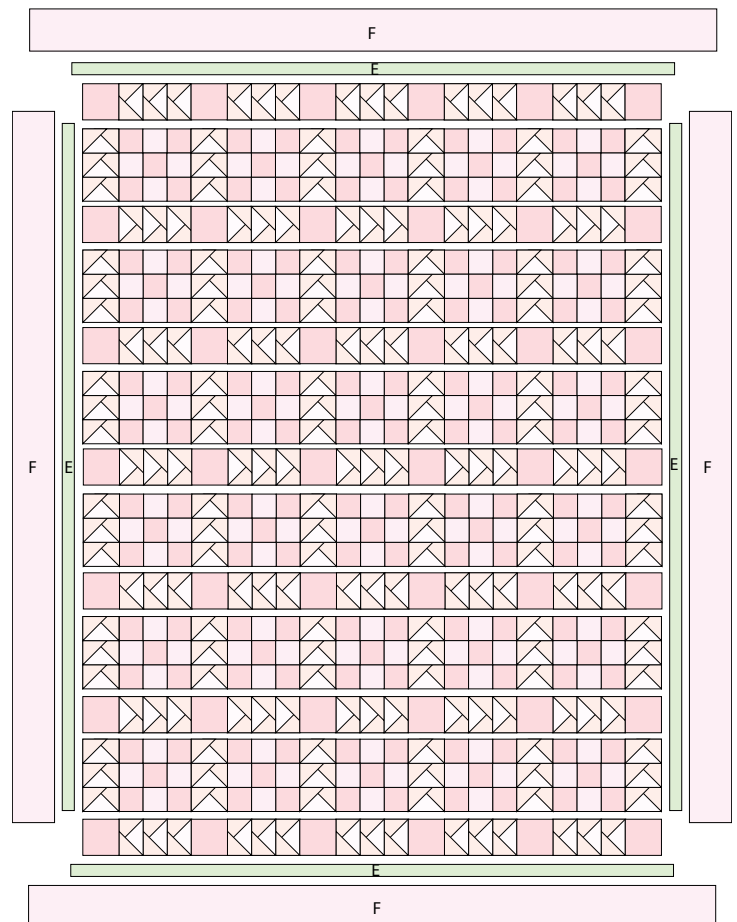
13. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $57\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

14. Sew (1) 4 " x $59\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 4 " x $57\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
