⅔ yard	Polka Dots - Linen/Blue (B)	8879-41
¼ yard	Tossed Buttercups - Linen (C)	8877-44
⅞ yard	Small Calico - Spa Blue (D)	8874-11
⅞ yard	Paisley - Lilac (E)	8875-55
2 ⅛ yards	Polka Dots - Linen/Lilac (F)	8879-45
2 yards	Border Stripe - Linen (G)	8871-44
1 ⅛ yards	Allover Floral - Eggplant (H)	8873-58
1 yard	Awning Stripe - Eggplant (I)	8876-58*
⅔ yard	Polka Dots - Eggplant (J)	8879-58
5 ⅓ yards	Paisley - Lilac (Backing)	8875-55

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Allover Floral - Linen (A), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Polka Dots - Linen/Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Tossed Buttercups - Linen (C), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips.

#### From the Small Calico - Spa Blue (D), cut:

- (7) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Paisley - Lilac (E), cut:

- (7) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Polka Dots - Linen/Lilac (F), cut:

- (7) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 3 ½" squares.
- (7) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Border Stripe - Linen (G), cut:

- (5) 12 ½" x WOF strips. Fussy cut (49) 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips, each centered on a strip of flowers.

#### From the Allover Floral - Eggplant (H), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 78 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 71 ½" strips.

#### From the Awning Stripe - Eggplant (I), cut:

- 326" of 2 ½" bias strips for the binding.

#### From the Polka Dots - Eggplant (J), cut:

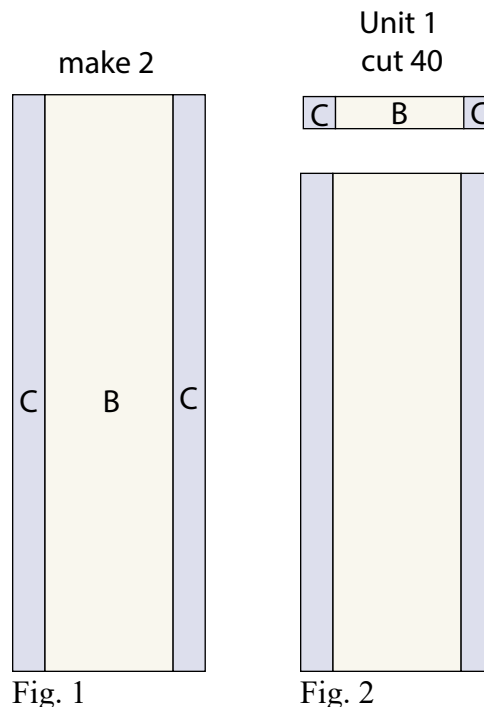
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Paisley - Lilac (Backing), cut:

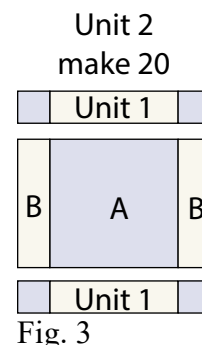
- (2) 94" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 79" x 94" back.

### Sewing Instructions

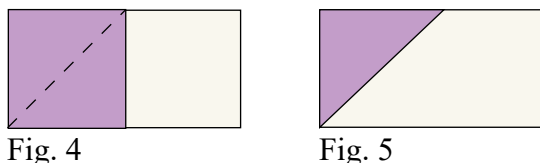
1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x WOF Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) CBC strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second CBC strip set.
2. Cut the CBC strip sets into (40) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).



3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (20) Unit 2 blocks total.



4. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.



5. Place (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 7).

6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (80) Unit 3 strips total.

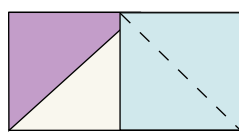

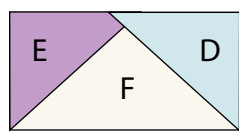

7. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 block. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.

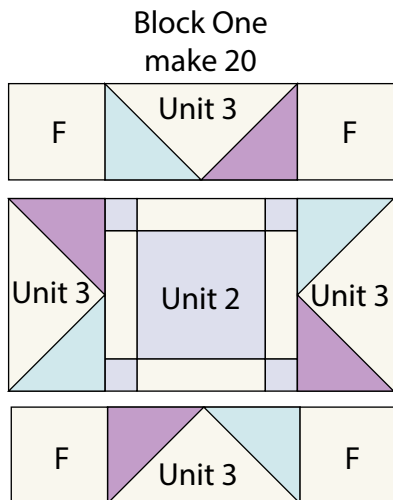

8. Sew (5)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares and (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip. Repeat to make (6) Sashing Strips total.

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

9. Sew (5)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strips and (4) Block One squares together lengthwise and alternating them to make (1) row. Repeat to make (5) rows total.

10. Sew the (6) Sashing Strips and (5) rows together, alternating them, to make the Center Block.

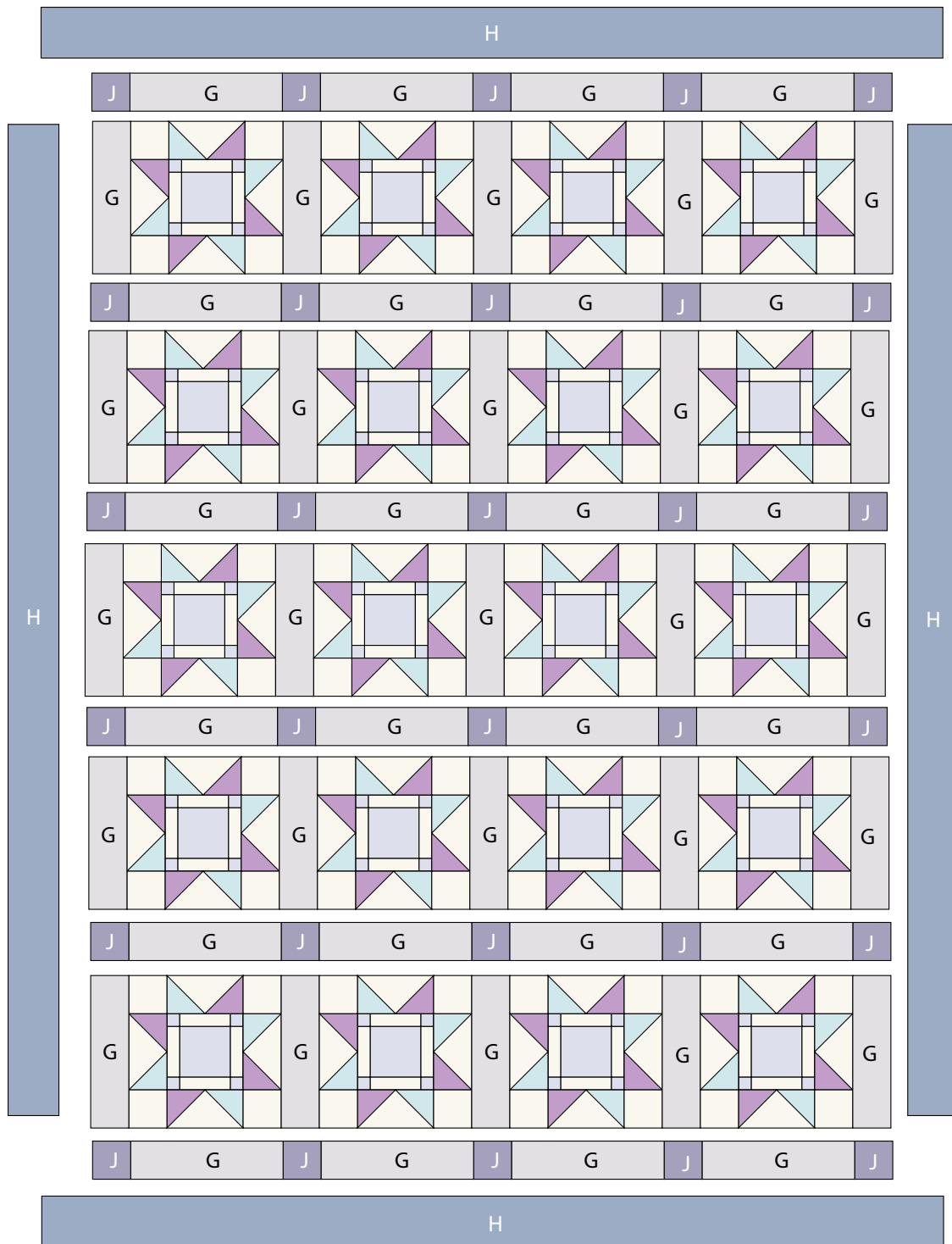
11. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $78\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $71\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the 326" of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " bias binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
