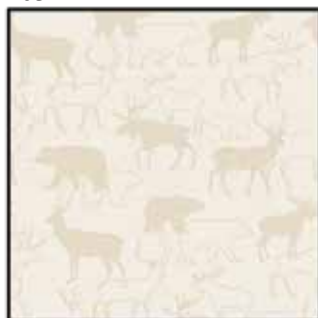

½ yard	Snowflake - Green (E)	F6811-66
⅞ yard	Animal Silhouette - Brown (F)	F6804-33
½ yard	Plaid - Red (G)	F6806-88
½ yard	Snowflake - Cream (H)	F6811-40
2 ⅞ yards	Novelty Stripe - Multi (I)	F6810-63
⅔ yard	Snowflake - Red (J)	F6811-88*
3 ¾ yards	Pinecones - Brown (Backing)	F6809-63

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Signs - Multi (A), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (13) 5 ½" squares.

From the Animals - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 5 ½" squares.

From the Birdhouses - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 5 ½" squares.

From the Cars/Campers Allover - Beige (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (13) 5 ½" squares.

From the Snowflake - Green (E), cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF strips.

From the Animal Silhouette - Brown (F), cut:

- (8) 3" x WOF strips.

From the Plaid - Red (G), cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF strips.

From the Snowflake - Cream (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 ½" strips.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ¼" x 72" LOF strips.
- (2) 5 ¼" x 62" LOF strips.

From the Snowflake - Red (J), cut:

- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Pinecones - Brown (Backing), cut:

- (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 76" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3" x WOF Fabric E strip and (1) 3" x WOF Fabric F strip together lengthwise to make (1) EF strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) EF strip sets total.
2. Cut the EF strip sets into (48) 3" x 5 ½" EF strips (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (2) EF strips together to make (1) Block One (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (24) Block Ones total.

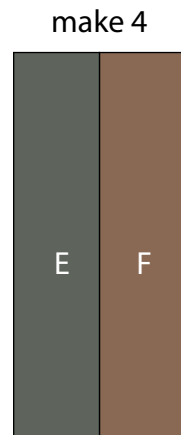

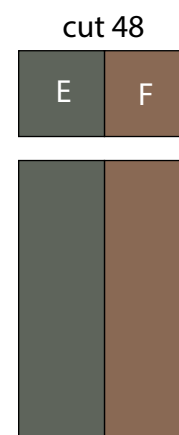

4. Sew (1) 3" x WOF Fabric G strip and (1) 3" x WOF Fabric F strip together lengthwise to make (1) GF strip set (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) GF strip sets total.
5. Cut the GF strip sets into (50) 3" x 5 ½" GF strips (Fig. 5).
6. Sew (2) GF strips together to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (25) Block Twos total.

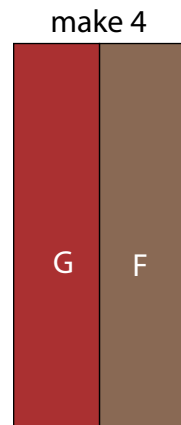

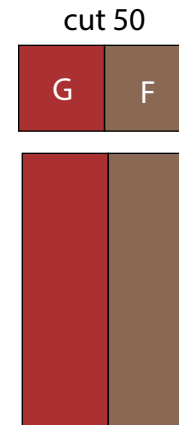

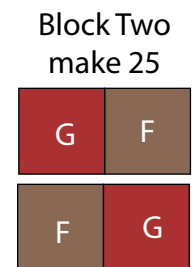

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Quilt 2

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

7. Sew (5) assorted 5 ½" squares, (2) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five, Seven, Nine and Eleven.
8. Sew (3) Block Twos, (4) assorted 5 ½" squares and (2) Block Ones together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Six and Ten.
9. Sew (3) Block Ones, (4) assorted 5 ½" squares and (2) Block Twos together to make Row Four. Repeat to make Row Eight.
10. Sew the eleven rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 2" x 55 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Center (1) 5 ¼" x 72" Fabric I strip on one side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) 5 ¼" x 62" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 7).

14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 7), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

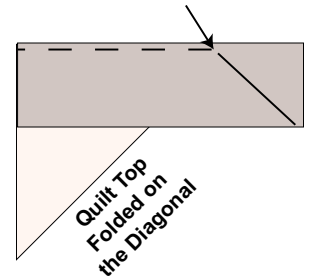


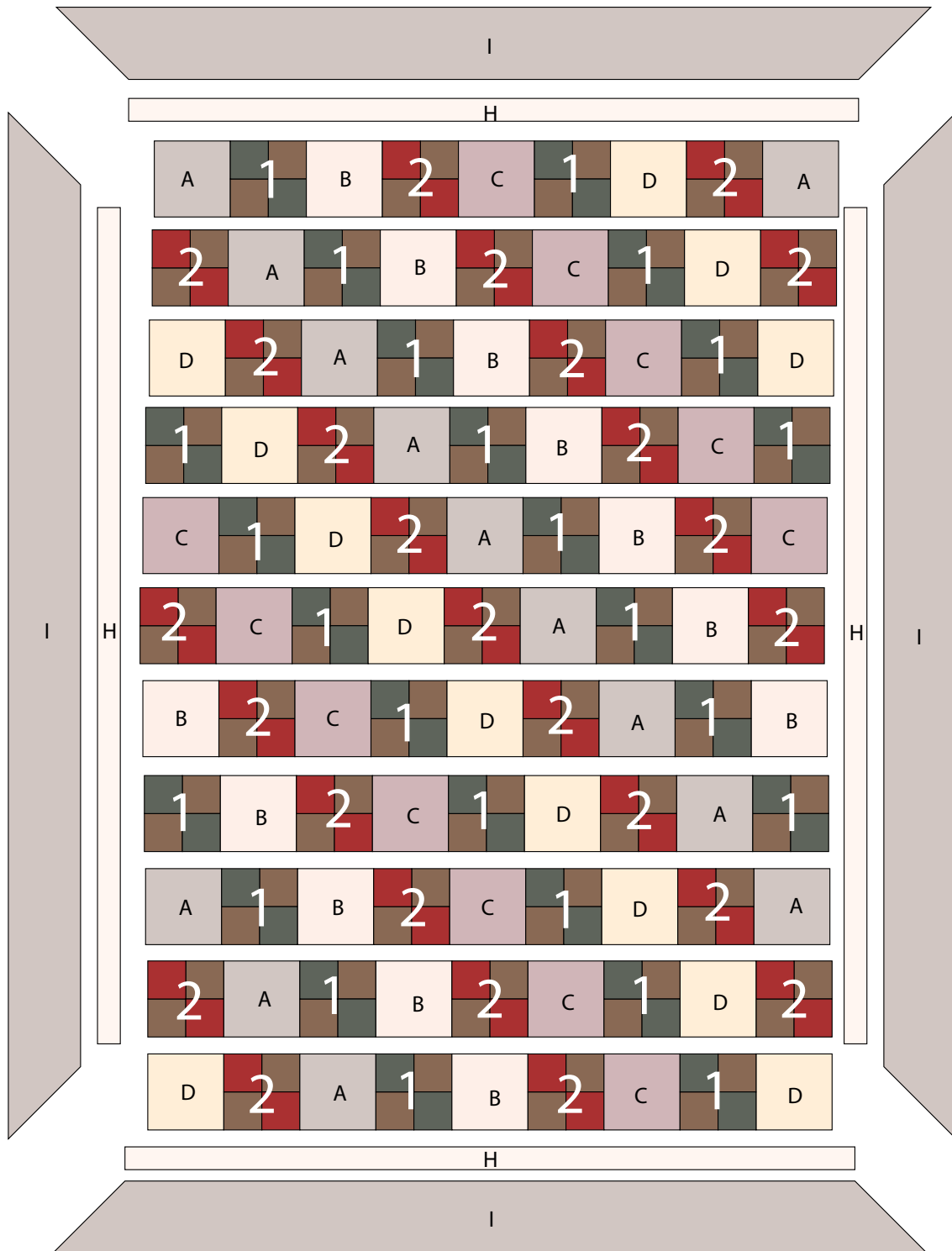

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
