# Strawberry Fields

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" x 68"**

**Finished Block Size 8" x 8"**

Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.pennyrosefabrics.com](http://www.pennyrosefabrics.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Strawberry Biscuit 10-inch Stacker (10-5100-21)

$1\frac{1}{8}$  yards (1.05 m) gray main (C5100 Gray)

$1\frac{1}{4}$  yards (1.15 m) blue daisy (C5106 Blue)

2 yards (1.85 m) Riley White Solid (C120 Riley White)

Binding  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard (60 cm)

Backing  $3\frac{3}{4}$  yard (3.45 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### 10-inch Stacker

Cut 10 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from each of the following assorted prints:

blue main, hot pink main

blue playdate, green playdate, pink playdate

green scallop, pink scallop, red scallop

blue poodle, hot pink poodle, pink poodle

aqua birds, green birds

aqua daisy, red daisy

### Gray Main

Cut 6 strips  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

### Blue Daisy

Cut 8 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 120 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 5 strips  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

### Riley White Solid

Cut 14 strips  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 180 squares  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut each square once diagonally to create 360 large triangles.

Cut 3 strips  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut the  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares twice diagonally to create 120 small triangles.

Cut 6 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

### Crisscross Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew a Riley white solid large triangle to each side of an assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.




Unit A

Sew 3 assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to create Unit B.




Unit B

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of Unit B to create Unit C.



Unit C

Sew a Riley white solid small triangle on each corner of Unit C to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit


# Strawberry Fields

Sew a Riley white solid large triangle to each side of blue daisy  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Unit E. Repeat to create 4 Unit Es.



Unit E

Sew a Unit E to each side of the Center Unit to complete the Crisscross Block. Repeat to create 30 Crisscross Blocks.

## Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for Crisscross Block placement. Lay out the blocks in 6 rows of 5 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be  $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $46\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Border 2

Side borders should be  $54\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $50\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Border 3

Side borders should be  $58\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $60\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Strawberry Biscuit Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
