

TOY BOX

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" x 691/4"

Finished Block Size 31/4" x 31/4"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Toy Chest 2 10-inch Stacker (10-5610-35) % yard (60 cm) blue animals (C5613 Blue) 1¼ yards (1.15 m) aqua bo peep (C5618 Aqua) 1¾ yards (1.3 m) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White) Binding ¼ yard (60 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

10-Inch Stacker


Cut 2 squares 3¾" x 3¾" and 2 rectangles 2½" x 3¾" from the following assorted prints:

pink duck, purple duck, yellow duck

Using the Cutting Diagram, cut 1 square 3¾" x 3¾" and 7 rectangles 2½" x 3¾" from the following assorted prints: orange circle, aqua floral

Using the Cutting Diagram, cut 1 square 3¾" x 3¾" and 8 rectangles 2½" x 3¾" from the following assorted prints: blue elephant, green elephant, orange elephant, pink elephant, blue animals, green animals, pink animals, purple animals, pink circle, red circle, teal circle, green floral, purple floral, yellow floral, orange daisy, teal daisy, yellow daisy, aqua bo peep, red bo peep, yellow bo peep, green plaid, red plaid Cut 8 rectangles 2½" x 3¾" from blue daisy. Cut 9 rectangles 2½" x 3¾" from the following assorted prints:

blue dog, purple dog, red dog, blue plaid



Cutting Diagram

Blue Animals

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

Aqua Bo Peep

Cut 7 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 2.

Riley White Solid

Cut 7 strips $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 69 squares $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Cut 1 strip 4" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 squares 4" x 4". Cut each square once diagonally to create 4 corner triangles.

Cut 2 strips 6½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 squares 6½" x 6½". Cut each square twice diagonally to create 40 setting triangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Two-Patch Block

Sew 2 assorted print $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles together to create the Two-Patch Block. Repeat to create 120 Two-Patch Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Two-Patch Block, assorted print 3¾" square, Riley white solid 3¾" square, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving ¼" seam allowance on all sides.

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Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 55%". Top and bottom borders should 50%".

Border 2

Side borders should be 59%". Top and bottom borders should 60%".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Toy Chest 2 Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.

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
