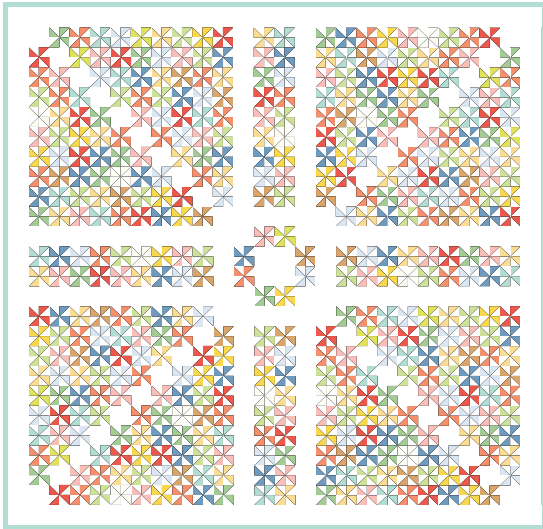
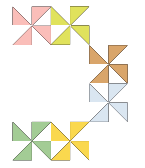


Kimberly's 2019 Challenge: Use Your Scraps Pinwheel Patchwork



Finished size: 52 1/2" x 52 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

Make your quilt with scraps that are approximately 4" square.

220 - 4" Dark squares (Fabric A)

220 - 4" Light squares (Fabric B)

1 1/4 yards background

5/8 yard binding

3 1/2 yards backing

Notions:

Two Rolls - 1" Half Square Triangle Paper

Triangles on a Roll #H100

Cut into sections of two by two.



Cutting:

Cut background fabric into:

1 - 4 1/2" square (Fabric C)

8 - 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles (Fabric D)

4 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (Fabric E)

44 - 2 1/2" squares (Fabric F)

6 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric G)

Cut binding fabric into

6 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric H)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly:

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric B scrap with a Fabric A scrap.

Place a 1" Triangles on a Roll two by two section on top and pin in place.

Set stitch length to 1.5 and sew on the dotted lines.

Cut apart on the solid lines.

Small Half Square Triangle Unit should measure

1 1/2" x 1 1/2".



Make 1,760.

Assemble four matching Half Square Triangle Units.

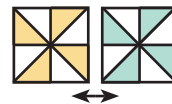
Pinwheel Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".



Make 440.

Assemble two Pinwheel Units.

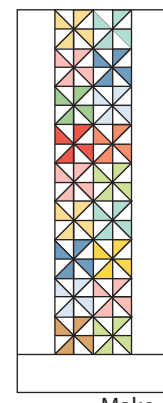
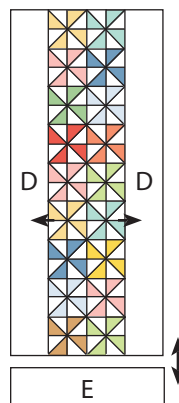
Pinwheel Pair Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".



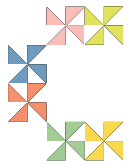
Make 40.

Assemble two Fabric D rectangles, nine Pinwheel Pair Units and one Fabric E rectangle.

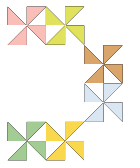
Cross Block should measure 8 1/2" x 20 1/2".



Make 4.



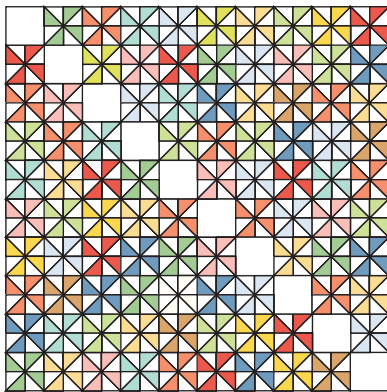
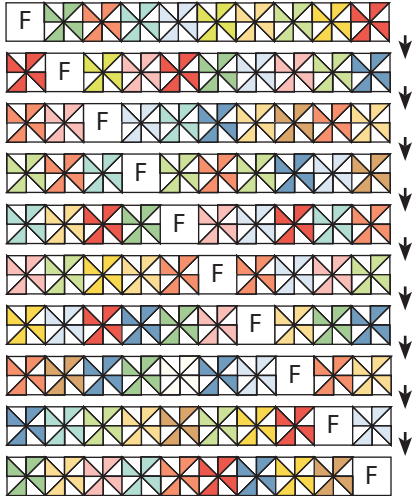

Assemble ten Fabric F squares and ninety Pinwheel Units.

Press rows in opposite directions

Corner Block should measure 20 1/2" x 20 1/2".

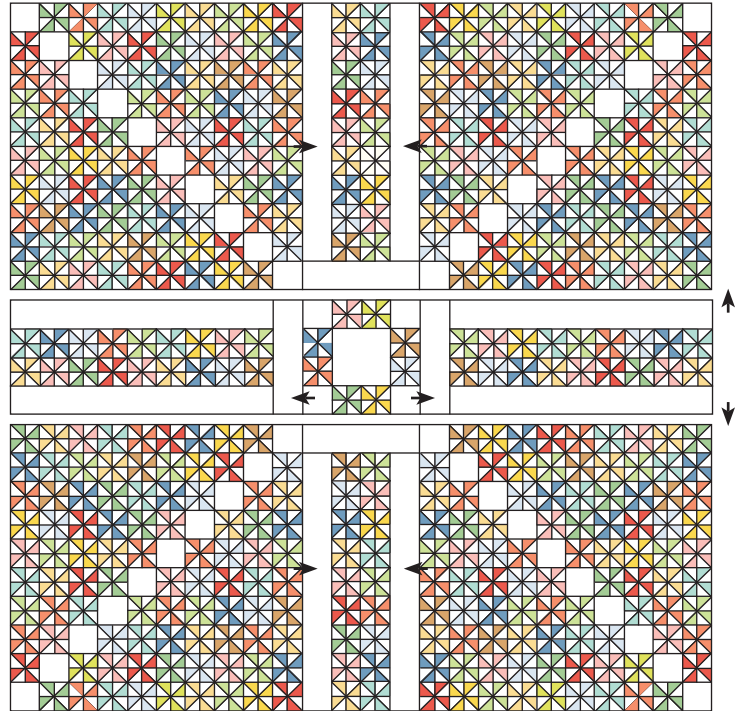


Make 4.

Quilt Center:

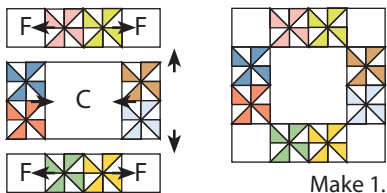
Assemble Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 48 1/2" x 48 1/2".

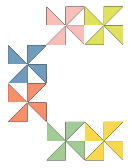


Assemble four Fabric F squares, four Pinwheel Pair Units and the Fabric C square.

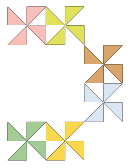
Center Block should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".



Make 1.

Borders:

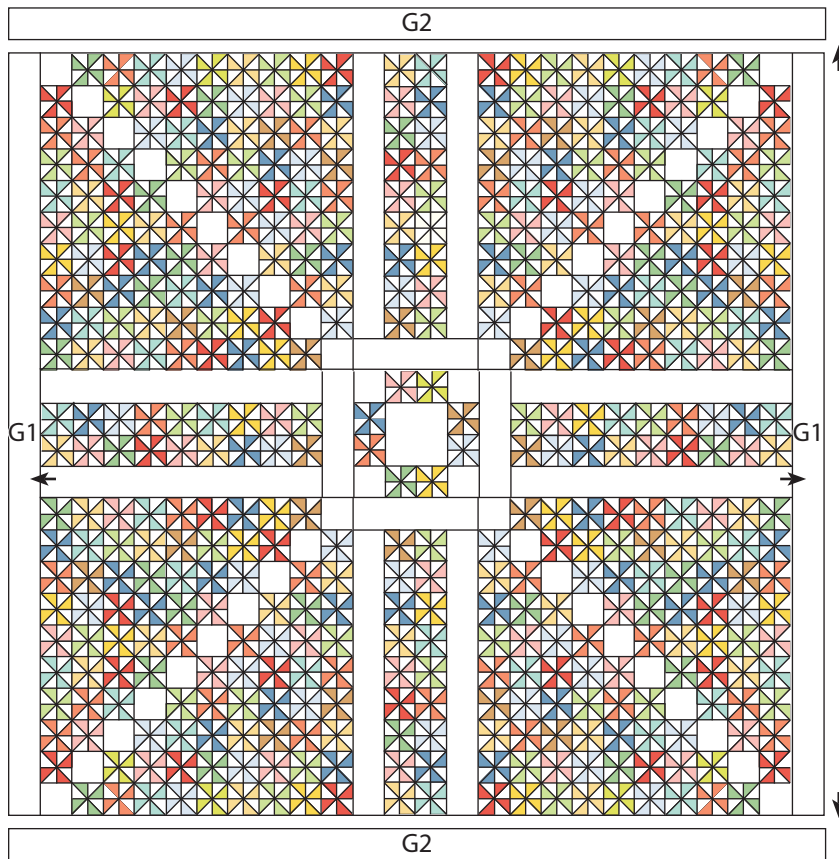
Piece the Fabric G strips end to end and subcut into:

2 - 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips (Side Borders - G1)

2 - 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips (Top and Bottom Borders - G2)

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric H strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
