SUPER STAR

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 58"

Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 yard (95 cm) blue main (C4830 Blue)

1/3 yard (35 cm) cream circle (C4831 Cream)

5/8 yard (60 cm) navy circle (C4831 Navy)

5/8 yard (60 cm) navy argyle (C4832 Navy)

1/3 yard (35 cm) orange argyle (C4832 Orange)

1/3 yard (35 cm) cream star (C4833 Cream)

3/8 yard (35 cm) blue gingham (C4834 Blue)

3/8 yard (35 cm) blue denim (C4835 Blue)

5/8 yard (60 cm) navy denim (C4835 Navy)

1/3 yard (35 cm) red denim (C4835 Red)

1 3/4 yards (1.65 m) snow shade (C200-03 Snow)

Binding 5/8 yard (60 cm)

Backing 3 2/3 yards (3.4 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Blue Main

Cut 6 strips 4 1/2" x WOF for Border 4.

Cream Circle

Cut 1 strip 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" and 8 squares 3" x 3".

Navy Circle

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2" and 4 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Navy Argyle

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2" and 4 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Orange Argyle

Cut 1 strip 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" and 8 squares 3" x 3".

Cream Star

Cut 1 strip 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" and 8 squares 3" x 3".

Blue Gingham

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" and 4 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Blue Denim

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" and 4 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Navy Denim

Cut 5 strips 3 1/2" x WOF for Border 3.

Red Denim

Cut 1 strip 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" and 8 squares 3" x 3".

Snow Shade

Cut 2 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2" and 8 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 6 strips 5 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" and 24 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Cut 9 strips 1 1/2" x WOF for Borders 1 and 3.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Lucky Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 8 assorted print 3" squares. Place an assorted print 3" square on top of a snow shade or assorted print 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a 1/4" seam allowance and trim excess.

SUPER STAR

Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Small Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Small Flying Geese Units.



Small Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Small Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of an assorted print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew a snow shade or assorted print 3" square to each side of the 2 remaining Small Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Center Star.



Center Star

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 snow shade or assorted print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a snow shade or assorted print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a snow shade or assorted print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Large Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Large Flying Geese Units.



Large Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Large Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of the Center Star. Sew a snow shade or assorted print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of the 2 remaining Large Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Lucky Star Block. Repeat to create 4 Lucky Star Blocks.



Lucky Star Block

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $40\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $42\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $42\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 3

Side borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $50\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 4

Side borders should be $50\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $58\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Lucky Star Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
