FINISHED QUILT SIZE 20" x 20"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) gray main (C5130 Gray)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) gray uniform (C5131 Gray)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) gray geometric (C5133 Gray)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) orange geometric (C5133 Orange)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) yellow XO (C5134 Yellow)

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm) multi stripe (C5136 Multi)

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (35 cm) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White)

Binding $\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm)

Backing $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Gray Main, Gray Uniform, Gray Geometric, Yellow XO

Cut 1 square $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ", 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 squares 3" x 3" from each print.

Orange Geometric

Cut 2 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border.

Cut 1 square $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " for post.

Riley White Solid

Cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 32 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 1 strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " for sashing.

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 8 squares 3" x 3".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 Riley white solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. With right sides together, place a Riley white solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of an assorted print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of an assorted print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an assorted print 3" square. With right sides together, place an assorted print 3" square on top of a Riley white solid 3" square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 4 Half Square Triangles.



Half Square Triangle

Sew a Half Square Triangle to each side of a Flying Geese Units to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.

Star Block (Continued)

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to create the Star Block. Repeat to create 4 Star Blocks.



Star Block

Blocks and Sashing

Refer to the quilt photo for block and sashing placement. Sew a Star Block to each side of a Riley white solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Repeat to make 2 block and sashing rows.

Sashing and Post

Refer to the quilt photo for sashing and post placement. Sew a Riley white solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to each side of an orange geometric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to complete the sashing and post row.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Side borders should be $18\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $20\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Play Ball 2 Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
