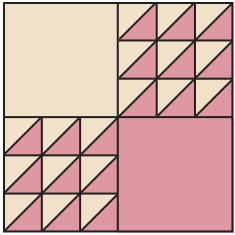


Wild Geese Straight Furrows Quilt Block




Unfinished size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Cutting Instructions:

One Block	
Block Color 	1 - 6" x 18" rectangle (A) 1 - 6 1/2" square (B)
Block Background 	1 - 6" x 18" rectangle (C) 1 - 6 1/2" square (D)
2" Half Square Triangle Paper Triangles on a Roll #H200	1 - two by five section (10 squares) 



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Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly:

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric C rectangle with the Fabric A rectangle.

Place the Triangles on a Roll Section on top and pin in place.

Set stitch length to 1.6 and sew on the dotted lines.

Cut apart on the solid lines.

Half Square Triangle Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

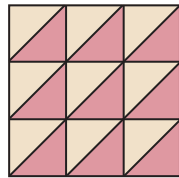
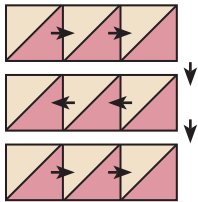
You will not use two Half Square Triangle Units.



Make 20.

Assemble nine Half Square Triangle Units.

Wild Geese Unit should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 2.

Assemble the Wild Geese Straight Furrows Block.

Wild Geese Straight Furrows Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
